God has given about what we can pray for and when we can pray. Concerning these promises, the Scripture memory passage for this term brings into focus Jesus' words on prayer in Matthew 7:7, "Ask and it shall be given to you; seek and you will find; knock and it shall be opened to you."

What Jesus describes here is an astounding invitation concerning the approach and access that we have to God through prayer. At the most basic level, the Lord's words describe prayer in terms of asking. Asking is about making a request. When the Apostle Paul spoke of prayer he encouraged this asking as an antidote to anxiety (See Phil 4:6). The need that each of us has for prayer is because of the neediness of our human condition. The Christian author Paul Tripp says, "Sin makes us comprehensively needy. Every area of our personhood has been in some way damaged by sin. We don't desire what we should. We don't think as we should. We don't speak as we should. We don't act as we should. We need help. We need rescue. We need wisdom. We need forgiveness. We need strength". Yes, and what this means is that we need prayer.

It is the provision of prayer to a prayer hearing God that is on offer to each of us. "And if we know that he hears us—whatever we ask—we know that we have what we asked of him" (1 John 5:15).
